Sixth Grade GSE: S6E3



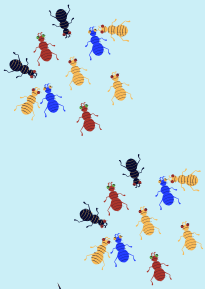
Students play a game to discover the various pathways of water through the natural and human water cycles.

Students perform water quality tests to explore how abiotic factors can impact life in our streams.

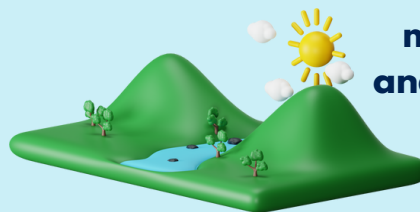
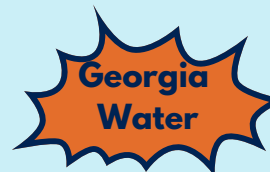


Eighth Grade GSE: SS8G1
