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This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and **modifies** the original ITB documents as noted below:

1. **QUESTION:**

Could you tell me who the end user of AED's would be (Fire Dept., Police Dept., office buildings etc.)?

RESPONSE:

The Department of Real Estate and Asset Management has overall responsibility for the County's Automated External Defibrillators (AED) Program via a Board of Commissioners (BOC) Resolution mandate.

However, these AED devices will replace current end of cycle AED devices that were purchased in 2003/2004, that are installed in public facilities countywide, i.e., Libraries, Senior Centers, Recreation Centers, Court and Jail facilities, etc.

2. **QUESTION:**

What are the units being traded in and their models?

RESPONSE:

Cardiac Science Powerheart AED Model 9300A

3. **QUESTION:**

Does the winning bidder have to be an authorized distributor of that product?

RESPONSE:

Yes (Assuming by "product" they mean the AED that they are recommending in their bid; then they would need to be an authorized distributor)

4. **QUESTION:**

Will bids including no-charge product, services, or extras be considered?

RESPONSE:

Yes (Assuming that an example of a no-charge product or service would be throwing in a trainer unit or six months free monitoring services, etc.)

5. **QUESTION:**

Will the bid be an exact match per the bid specifications?

RESPONSE:

At a minimum, the bid specifications should be met in terms of product functionality, however a product that offers additional features will be considered.

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****PLEASE NOTE****

Minimum warranty requirements: 2 years on pads, 4 years on batteries and 7 years on the Automated External Defibrillator (AED) unit itself.
