This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and **modifies** the original RFP documents as noted below:

The following questions were posed of the aforementioned RFP project:

QUESTION 1: For the In-Car routers, does Fulton County have a preferred installer or in-house installer to work with?

ANSWER 1: We have used Atlanta Communications for the majority of the installations of this type of equipment; however, due to the quantity of routers that would be needed for this project and the expected cost, this service would be required to go out for quote or bid.

QUESTION 2: Do the computers (MDT) in the vehicle(s) run Windows 7 or above?

ANSWER 2: The computers run on Windows 7 Professional, 64-BIT.

QUESTION 3: Does the MDT have a free USB port? Does it have at least 25 GB of free storage?

ANSWER 3: Yes to both questions.

QUESTION 4: Can the MDT remotely access the internet?

ANSWER 4: Yes.

QUESTION 5: We acknowledge from Addendum #2 that Sprint is currently your Wi-Fi provider. Can you please tell us if you Wi-Fi was deployed to support day to day usage for local computers and MDTs/MDCs – but was it also deployed to support other products like dash-cameras or CCTV?

ANSWER 5: Yes, it was deployed for day to day usage for local computers and MDT's/MDC's. No, it was not initially deployed to support dash-cameras or CCTV.

QUESTION 6: Does Fulton County currently have wireless offload for an existing camera system?

ANSWER 6: No.

QUESTION 7: Are there currently network access points set up in the parking lot of the station?

ANSWER 7: Yes, at 3-locations.

QUESTION 8: Was your Wi-Fi deployment performed by PD internal IT, a contractor or 3rd party, or as part of a larger city wide/county wide deployment?

ANSWER 8: County wide deployment.

QUESTION 9: If additional network access points are needed, does Fulton County have a preferred installer or in-house installer to work with?

ANSWER 9: Due to the expected cost, the service would be required to go out for quote or bid.

QUESTION 10: In reference to the RFP for Body Worn and In Car Cameras, is Fulton County open to reviewing an on premise focused storage solution vs. requiring Cloud storage?

ANSWER 10: No, Cloud Based storage is required, as requested in the RFP.
