Question#1: What is the maximum budget amount for this project?

Answer: We are looking at proposed cost.

Question#2: How many youth participants are enrolled in the program?

Answer: Currently, 376 clients are in the program

Question#3: What is the age range of the program participants?

Answer: The age range is 16 and 24 per WIOA regulations.

Question#4: What were the criteria for acceptance into the program for each participant?

Answer: The eligibility requirements are based on the WIOA law

Question#5: Are there any designated career pathways used as a focus for the program?

Answer: The career pathways are based on the client's interest, and are not Program specific.

Question#6: Where and how will the program be executed?

Answer: The Job Readiness service training should be hosted and held by the approved provider, but can be co-located within a Fulton County building, such as a library, once approved. All trainings must be held inside Fulton County
