Page Two

This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and **modifies** the original ITB documents as noted below:

- In the pricing forms from the prior bid, the County stipulated where vendors had to list where each material was going to be disposed of. Do you want us to list our disposal sites again on the pricing forms? It is only necessary to list the facilities, if the pricing is different
- In the pricing forms from the prior bid, the County included tires and white goods/metals. Is the county going to add these items for this bid?
Please provide a price for the roll off pull for white goods; Exclude tires
- If you include white goods/metals in the pricing form, does the County designate where the white goods/metals are be disposed of? No facility will be designated
- What is expected of the vendor for the County's amnesty days once a quarter? Vendor will be required to provide roll off containers
- How many 40 yard open tops per location are you requesting? Roll off containers are required at the Merk Miles facilities; the smaller containers are resulting in excess pull charges due to smaller capacity of containers less than 40 yards.
- At the Merk TS you currently have 2 containers for metal, 2 containers for Yard Waste, and 6 containers that are mixed with C&D and MSW. Will we be hauling all 8 containers? Yes
- Would the County consider separating the waste at Merk by having a portion of the 6 containers designated for C&D only and the rest for MSW only? NO; limited space for the placement of additional containers
- How many containers are at each of the other facilities? Between 1 and 4 containers;
- What are the average tons per haul for the containers at each facility?
The tonnage varies; 1.5-6 tons

- Will the County be delivering waste to our Landfill with their own vehicles? If so, how many tons per month? If not, why is there a 25 mile distance limitation? Yes; The county delivers solid waste
- What is the annual number of hauls from each facility? The total number of pulls is approximately 1000-1200 /per year all facilities; Merk Miles represents 97% of pulls
- What are the total numbers of tons per year for all facilities? Total tonnage is 6000 tons/year; Merk Miles presents 97%
- Do all of the containers have to be hauled to the same facility or can we use multiple destinations i.e., Transfer Station, C&D Landfill, MSW Landfill? No; multiple facilities can be used
- The bid price sheet asks for a rate per ton on Dead Animals? How are the animals contained and hauled? How many loads per month do you generate? Dead animals are incidental; 2 or 3 animals a month; delivered by County to the landfill facility.
- How many tons per year do you generate in Dead Animals? Dead animals are incidental; 2 or 3 animals a month
- How many tons per year do you generate in Construction/Demolition? Unknown; currently mixed with MSW waste
- How many tons per year do you generate in Yard Waste? 1000 ton/per year
- How many tons per year do you generate in MSW? 5000/tons per year
- You have a Bid Form in Section 2 that asks for a Base Bid Amount. Given the fact that we have not been given an exact number of hauls and tonnages from each location it is impossible to calculate this number. Is your intent to use the Bid Price Sheet in Section 10 only and therefore we should disregard the Bid Form in Section 2? The answer has been provide in this addendum

- In Section 1 Minimum Participation of Requirements for Prime Contractors it states that the Prime Contractor must perform at least 51%. Is there a penalty if we, the bidder and Prime Contractor, submit our bid with no sub-contractor and the intent to perform 100% of the work of the contract? No
