Dear Vendor

Attached is one (1) copy of Addendum 2, hereby made a part of the above referenced ITB. Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions in the ITB referenced above remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

The following information is offered in response to questions and requests for clarification.

**Question:** How many trailers are currently being used or will be needed at the Johns Creek Environmental Campus location?

**Answer:** Currently two roll off boxes are being used for dewatered sludge and one for grit. One trailer is required for dewatered sludge three times per week and one roll off box for grit every week at this time.

**Question:** Currently, how often (days per week) are the trailers being transported to landfill?

**Answer:** JCEC is in startup mode and will start sludge and grit hauling/disposal soon. We estimate sludge will be hauled from the site three times per week.

**Question:** How is the sludge being processed (using a press or centrifuge)?

**Answer:** The sludge is dewatered by centrifuge.

**Question:** Can this material be land applied? If yes, can you provide analytical results?

**Answer:** It **cannot** be land applied.

**Question:** What is your current pricing for this ITB?

**Answer:** The County has not disposed of any sludge to the landfill and does not have a price.

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**Question:** Is the estimated total volume of Sludge----- 2500 Wet Tons, as noted on page 56 of bid packet, or is it more?

**Answer:** The estimated volume is 2500 Wet Tons.

**Question:** How much is estimated being hauled each day or week?

**Answer:** It is estimated to haul 84 wet tons per week.

**Question:** If notified to haul a load on Saturday, will notification be prior to land fill closure at 12:00 Noon. This will prevent sludge from being in container over the weekend.

**Answer:** Yes, the hauler will be notified in advance.

**Question:** According to the bid packet, hauling is allowed Monday thru Saturday. Is this amended based on information obtained during the pre-bid meeting to Monday-Thursday?

**Answer:** It is Monday thru Saturday as per bid.


**Question:** Are there any requirements for DBE, MFBE, WBE, or any other disadvantage businesses for this contract to be awarded? If so, what is the percentage to be awarded?

**Answer:** There are no percentages required for minority participation.

**Question:** Is it necessary for a contractor to have a contract with a land fill establishment to be considered for this contract? Or is it okay to be cash on delivery customer (COD)?

**Answer:** The awarded vendor is required to have a contract with the landfill to dispose of the sludge.
