1. Questions: Would the Department consider alternative equipment?

Answer: No, this solicitation is for the monitoring services only.

2. Questions: If yes – we have the following clarification questions:
  - a. Page 5 – GPS Tracking Bullet – Full Activity Reporting
    - i. Please define Full Activity Reporting

Answer: 2 minute postings for locations, speed, and tracks. Historical data maintained for up to 12 months.

3. Questions: b. Page 5 – Remote Diagnostics Bullet – Full Vehicle Reporting
  - i. Please define Full Vehicle Reporting

Answer: Vehicle diagnostics such as fault codes.

4. Questions: c. Page 5 – Special Conditions/Instructions
  - i. Tampering Policy – please explain what tampering you are referring to...what past situations have occurred that cause you to request this

Answer: The units should not have easy access to disable or remove.

5. Questions: ii Full Reporting Capabilities – this is a repeat – but we need to understand what your requirements are or what your definition of “full Reporting Capability” is.

Answer: Data available from the vehicle or gps receiver. Managers need to have ability to query and generate reports.
