Questions concerning 13RFP88502C-DR, APCO P25 Phase 2 TDMA 800 MHZ Simulcast Trunked Radio System

We would like to request clarification/additional information on the following items specific to the RFP document:

- 1. Request an extension to the due date of 6 weeks.**
Proposal turnaround times for projects of an equivalent size as Fulton County are longer than the 3 weeks the county has allotted for this RFP. Two examples of recent similar size P25 RFPs are Clermont County, OH which had an 18 week turnaround (one new site) and Mercer County, NJ which had a 7 week turnaround (all existing sites.)

Response: No. Fulton County has to adhere to section 1.11 Procurement Schedule of the proposal document .

- 2. Allow vendors to perform site surveys of existing and proposed sites.**
Both entities identified in item 1 allowed time for the vendors to perform site surveys. Site surveys allow vendors to provide the county with the most cost competitive proposals by quantifying the condition of the sites. Without performing a site survey, vendors will need to add significant money to the proposals in order to manage the risk of not knowing the condition of the sites

Also note that the "Solicitation ID", located right under the Description on the webpage, and the "Sign In Sheet", also on the webpage, displays **13RFP88502C-DR**.

Response: The correct proposal number is 13RFP88502C-DR, APCO P25 Phase 2 TDMA 800 MHZ Simulcast Trunked Radio System.

5. When you click on the bid file hyperlink, you see the third screen capture below, which is the file that opens and is entitled **13RFP87425C-DR**.

Response: The correct proposal number is 13RFP88502C-DR, APCO P25 Phase 2 TDMA 800 MHZ Simulcast Trunked Radio System.

6. I respectfully ask for clarification of the three different RFP numbers (**13RFP88502C-DR**, **13RFP87425C-DR**, and **13RFP87425C-DR_2**).

Response: The proposal file number, and the correct proposal number is 13RFP88502C-DR, APCO P25 Phase 2 TDMA 800 MHZ Simulcast Trunked Radio System.

7. Also, is there a revision 2 file as noted by the third RFP suffix **DR_2**?
