

This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and **modifies** the original RFP documents as noted below:

QUESTIONS AND **RESPONSES**

QUESTION: Page 48- Regarding the request for samples, if we are bidding the exact brand and part number is it necessary to submit samples? If we are submitting samples, is it necessary to submit every line item on the bid?

RESPONSE: *If you are bidding the exact brand and part number you would not need to submit samples. Samples are only required when the bidder is bidding what he states is an equivalent. You would not need to submit samples for all items, unless they are deemed equivalents.*

QUESTION: Page 76- On the bid pricing sheet there are several line items where there is a substantial price difference between the part numbers that are listed such as long sleeve and short sleeve. Line items 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, etc. How are these to be priced? Also I did not see any provision for over-size charges and there are some line items that carry large price differences between regular sizes and over-sizes.

RESPONSE: *They are to be priced as specified. There are no provisions for oversized items. There shall be no up-charge for "Female," Bid and Tall, or B cut garments.*
