## Answers to Questions Submitted for ITB 14ITB91616C-DR

1. How far off the structure are we to cover for the pests listed in bid. (esp, Fire Ants, and mosquitos)

**Response:** Fulton County Government is requiring a 20 foot radius from the structure.

2. If subcontractor we are wanting to use for Wildlife portion is already a registered vendor with Fulton County . Do we still need to submit paperwork in bid to work as subcontractor.

**Response:** The County wants all sub-contractors to be listed within each company's documents so that the County knows that the sub and prime contractor has agreed upon the amount of work and the dollar value of the services being performed.

3. Jail Complex?

- a. Square footage of the kitchen

**Response:** approximately 2500 square feet

- b. Number of beds of facilities

**Response:** 1325 beds located with the facilities

4. Georgia does not have a prevailing wage law. However, if this is a public works contract subject to federal laws for any reason (such as the type of project, the funding for the project, etc), there is a possibility it could be a prevailing wage job under Davis Bacon. Unfortunately, there simply is not enough information here for me to be able to determine that. I urge the business to seek clarification prior to bidding for the job as to whether or not Davis Bacon rates apply to this project so that the proper amount for wages can be considered for bidding purposes.

**Response:** There are no federal funds associated with this bid document and the State of Georgia does not have any prevailing wage law; therefore, Davis Bacon rates are not applicable to this bid.

5. Regarding background checks, Danielle Barnett from our associate relations dept commented that she needs a scope defined for the disqualifying offenses listed. And, how many years do they require the background check to go back?

**Response:** As a Governmental Agency, we use GCIC to check criminal history. There are no limitations on how far back GCIC goes. Any felony, drug, violent, contraband, or obstruction of a law enforcement officer charges would prevent a vendor/contractor from gaining access to the facility. Also, any pending or under sentence charges would also prevent access.

6. Just to verify we are not required to provide bid bond as stated in the meeting.

**Response:** Yes, there is a 5% bid bond associated with this project; however, there are no payment and performance bonds required once awarded.
