Please confirm/answer the following items some of which were discussed at yesterday's prebid conference:

- A) Minimum qualification requirements on page ITB 1-1 are not restricted to Trane. Experience with other manufacturers is acceptable.

Response: Yes.

- B) Please explain the difference between b. in this section and the requested references. It appears to be redundant.

Response: Item B makes reference to specific job experience. Bidders may choose to provide different information for references.

- C) What exactly is required relative to duct cleaning called for on page 9-2. Is there a specification? Does this apply to the ductwork on the unit that has already been replaced?

Response: The supply and return air grills and registers are to be cleaned. Yes this applies to all supply and return grills.

- D) Curb adapters are acceptable in lieu of new factory curbs specified.

Response: Yes.

- E) Units by Carrier, Lennox or York, as well as Trane are acceptable.
