

Page Two**

This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and answers questions that vendors have asked concerning the specifications:

1. **Page 51. #4. Staffing Patterns. You require contractor to supply personnel in sufficient number as required to provide service type and coverage as indicated herein, to include relief for lunch and rest breaks, at no additional cost to county. Question: Does your staffing plan as outlined in ITB currently provide for the personnel needed to comply with this requirement? No**

2. **Are current security guards members of an organized Union?**
Not to my knowledge.

3. **ITB states required On-the-Job training to be at 40 hours. Question: Can we assume that any guards that the new vendor transitions from previous vendor will not need to be included in the mandatory 40 hours of OJT?**
The security officers that are already employed with the current vendor does not have to train an additional 40 hrs.

4. **Page 55. A. Vehicle requirements. Question: Please provide clarification on requirements of said vehicle. Is contractor responsible for providing said vehicle? Will vehicle be charged to Fulton County as a direct billed item? If answer is yes, what is estimated miles per month that vehicle is driven? Yes, it is the contractor's responsibility to provide a vehicle for the stadium parking lot. No the vehicle service is not billable. Mileage is not reported to Fulton County Police Department.**

5. **Page 55. B. Radios. Question: Is contractor responsible for providing radios or will Fulton County supply said radios? The contractor is responsible for providing enough radios for your security staff. See the Staffing Plan Requirements.**

6. **According to page 65, the contractors work week must start on Sunday and end on Saturday. Our work week start on Saturday and end on Friday. Would it be a problem changing the work week to match our existing work week? Yes, it would be a problem; the invoices must be processed in three sections Security, Procurement, and Finance and we are not willing to change.**

7. **Prior to the award of the contract to a respondent vendor, will there be a mandatory site survey at any time? No, there will not be a mandatory site survey.**
