This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and modifies the original Bid documents as noted below:

Questions and Responses:

1. **QUESTION:** On the manhole depth table on the plans, the depth of the manhole between segments 4 and 5 shows to be approximately 7.5'. We found it to actually measure 13.5' in depth. Is there any as-builts available showing accurate depths of the sewer system or can Fulton County provide survey information from the design of this project?

RESPONSE: Information provided is the best available to the County at this time. Contractor to field verify.

2. **QUESTION:** Can a bid item be added for Fulton County's standard trench patch?

RESPONSE: No. See Section 01025. Include costs for patching with the item to which it pertains.

3. **QUESTION:** On page 2 of 5 of the bid form, it states, "no limit will be fixed for such increased or decreased quantities nor extra compensation allowed". It reads as if each bid item is lump sum. Please clarify. Do we assume that 3300 lf is all we get compensated for even if field measurements measure 3800 lf or will the contractor be compensated for actual quantities installed?

RESPONSE: See Section 00300, page 3, second paragraph, for clarification regarding payment for increased or decreased quantities.

4. **QUESTION:** In Section 01025 - 1.06 Pavement, The specifications state in Part A that no separate payment will be made for pavement patching and that all costs for patching should be included in the unit price. Then under that same section it states in Part B that payment for removing and replacing payment will be made at the unit price bid for Roadway Asphalt Resurfacing. Does this mean that if the contractor is bidding the job utilizing pipebursting that he/she will not be paid for the asphalt repair required to install the pipe?

RESPONSE: Correct. No separate payment will be made for pavement patching during pipe or lateral installation. All costs for patching shall be included in the unit price for the item to which it pertains, for example either Item 1 or Item 2 on the Bid Form. Item 3 - Roadway Asphalt Resurfacing will only be paid as described in Section 01025, Article 1.06, Paragraph B, and in 01010, Article 1.01, Paragraph F, after pipe and lateral installation is complete.
