**Also, the following questions were posed of the aforementioned ITB:**

We are interested in bidding on your upcoming maintenance contract opportunity for your Telecommunications systems. I realize the specifications call for an "all inclusive" parts/labor maintenance coverage—which is our preference—however in reviewing your systems, many of them are no longer supported by the manufacturer. This means acquiring parts may be challenging.

1. Will there be any allowance made for an older system when parts cannot be sourced?

Yes; provided that a reasonably thorough effort has been made by vendor to locate needed part or component.

2. Are Performance Bonds Required?

Performance Bonds are not required for this project.

3. Are Bid Bonds Required?

A Bid bond will not be required.

4. Are telephone sets a part of the maintenance? If so, can you list the analog and digital sets in each system?

No. Telephone sets are not part of the maintenance required in this bid.

5. Do you have the software loads that are in each system?

We have the software loads for several of the large pbx's (Juvenile Ct., Central Library, ADTC, and Government Center Voicemail system). We do not have the software loads for the remaining (primarily smaller) systems.

6. Can we use refurbished parts?

Fulton County expects factory new (not refurbished or rebuilt) parts to be used when available. However, if a needed part or component is discontinued by the original equipment manufacturer (OEM), and is no longer available from any known supplier, then rebuilt or refurbished parts are acceptable.

7. Can you give us a list of approved minority vendors that work on Avaya equipment?

No. We don't maintain any specific list of vendors that work on Avaya equipment.
