Addendum #2**

1. If the individual qualifies for Medicaid Residential Services and/or Waivers will this conflict with the bid rate from Fulton County.

Response: Persons who receive Medicaid Residential Services/Waivers are not eligible for funding under this program; they will not need it. This program is strictly for inmates being released from the jail that are **homeless and without benefits**.

2. Should the daily rate per diem include: Transportation, Adult Day Center, Medication, Co-payments, medical supplies, Nursing services or should we break the cost down per line item.

Response: The rate is to include: Room, board and transportation only. (Medical supplies, day services, medication, nursing services are not classified as Room and Board).

3. If the bidder's main office is not located in Fulton County would we need a main office their or can we use a satellite office.

Response: All facilities must be in located within the boundaries of Fulton County.
