**SPONSOR: SENATOR MICHAEL EGAN**


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The Fulton County Board of Commissioners approved submission of legislation to repeal the local constitutional amendment to the Georgia Constitution providing for a seven-member Planning Commission. There was a consensus of the Board that the best mechanism to form the membership of the Planning Commission would be for it to enact a local ordinance or resolution under the general auspices of state law.

On behalf of the County, Senator Egan introduced S.B. 653, which repeals the local constitutional amendment. Therefore, the Board of Commissioners will have the authority either by local ordinance or resolution to empanel the Planning Commission to reflect the geographical diversity of the County.

AN ACT

To repeal a constitutional amendment duly ratified at the 1978 general election (Res. Act. No. 145, House Resolution No. 568-1603, Ga. L. 1978, p. 2411) and proclaimed by the Governor to be a part of the Constitution of the State of Georgia providing for a seven-member Fulton County Planning Commission; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

Section 1. That constitutional amendment duly ratified at the 1978 general election (Res. Act. No. 145, House Resolution No. 568-1603, Ga. L. 1978, p. 2411) and proclaimed by the Governor to be a part of the Constitution of the State of Georgia providing for a seven-member Fulton County Planning Commission is repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
