

FULTON COUNTY TASK FORCE ON HIV/AIDS

Board Established by: County

Description:

This Board was established by the Fulton County Board of Commissioners by Resolution (Item #14-1109) at its December 17, 2014 Recess Meeting. This Board was established to address and minimize the transmission of HIV disease and to prevent the further spreading of AIDS within Fulton County. The purpose of the Board is to provide input and recommendations in areas of public education, advocacy, treatment, prevention, housing and related issues pertaining to HIV/AIDS within Fulton County.

Membership/Appointment:

Pursuant to Resolution #15-0109, adopted by the Board of Commissioners on February 4, 2015, the appointment process for the Fulton County Task Force on HIV/AIDS consists of the following amendments to the previous Board of Commissioners action (Item 14-1109) adopted on December 17, 2014 by adding the following requirements: The Fulton County Task Force on HIV/AIDS shall have the following members: The Director of the Fulton County Department of Health and Wellness and the Director of the Ryan White Program shall each be members. In addition, each Commissioner shall appoint two (2) members. The District appointees shall be residents of Fulton County, and shall have backgrounds in medicine or public health or be otherwise qualified to serve as Board members.

On December 16, 2015, a resolution (Item #15-1199) to amend and clarify the process for filling vacancies provided the following: The Director of Fulton County Department of Health and Wellness, and the Director of Ryan White Program, and the Director of the CDC High Impact Prevention Program shall each be ex-officio, non-voting advisers to the Task Force. For appointments that remain vacant as of January 1, 2016, names of persons will be recommended by Task Force co-charipersons for review and approval by the full Board of Commissioners. New appointees shall serve 2 year terms. Each member may continue to serve beyond his/her term until replaced. No term of any such District appointee member shall extend beyond the term of the Commissioner who appointed the member. Each member may continue to serve beyond his/her term until replaced.

Term:

After the initial terms, District appointees appointed to subsequent terms shall serve 2 year terms. No term of any such District appointee member shall extend beyond the term of the Commissioner who appointed the member. Each member may continue to serve beyond his/her term until replaced.
