

EXISTING ORDINANCE REQUIREMENTS

Sec. 62-39. Address numbers

f. For properties whose primary access is different from their lot frontage, address number shall be assigned and posted from the access point.







g. Each residential one-or two-family dwelling shall have its address number posted on a mailbox or addressing post located at or near the main entrance or vehicle access point to the property. Such address numbers shall have a minimum stroke height of three inches and shall be of a color that contrasts with the surrounding surface so as to be readily identifiable without obstruction from the edge of the roadway.

***SUGGESTED STANDARDS**

The address post shall not exceed 6" by 6". Address numbers shall not be placed within 18" of the ground. Address numbers shall have a minimum 1/2 inch between numbers. Address numbers must be clearly visible on both sides of the post, and shall face the direction of traffic. The post shall not be obstructed from view by any means. The property owner shall have the responsibility of ensuring compliance with the requirements of this section, regardless of whether the premises are leased or owner-occupied. A diagram has been provided as reference for acceptable and unacceptable installation and placements of address numbers on a post.

*Fulton County is currently drafting an amendment to the CBU standards to make these suggested standards mandatory.
