


RAISE STORED MATERIALS !



HOW TO CONTROL RATS


1 STARVE RATS OUT!

Store garbage and rubbish in tightly covered cans.




Rats will live in trash, and drink rain water in empty cans. Keep yards, lots, free from rubbish and garbage.




Store food properly. Keep pantries, sinks, food counters clean.

2 BUILD RATS OUT!

Basement windows should fit tightly, and have no broken panes.



RIGHT!

WRONG!



All openings $\frac{3}{8}$ " or wider in the foundation walls, and within 30" of the ground, should be rat-stopped with metal collars or cement.

GARBAGE IS RAT FOOD!

Be sure all garbage, rubbish, ashes in your yard is placed in containers.

Bird food should be placed on raised platforms.
