
Payment methods

NORTH FULTON REGIONAL HEALTH CENTER SERVICES

*Located at the Royal 400 Business Park in Alpharetta, the **North Fulton Regional Health Center** is Fulton County's premier preventive health facility serving Fulton County residents north of I-285.*

The center provides a vast array of public and preventive health services in spacious, state-of-the-art quarters.

Separate intake windows for clinical and nutrition/WIC services allow clients to be served faster. Three spacious waiting areas also ensure that clients have comfortable surroundings while they wait for service.

Strategically located near the entrance, the center's busy travel clinic is designed to get clients who need travel immunizations in and out fast.

With 14,625 square feet of space and clinics offering comprehensive services, North Fulton Regional Health Center is ready to serve you.



Child Health services assist in the prevention and early detection of health concerns among children from birth to young adulthood. From pediatric dental care to sports physicals and health assessments for teens, programs under Child Health Services ensure that north Fulton's youth receive quality, comprehensive health care.

Communicable Disease Prevention and Treatment involves a full range of services that help reduce the incidence of communicable disease in the community. These services include education, counseling, identification and treatment of sexually transmitted diseases. Confidential HIV counseling and testing and medication for many infections are provided on site. HIV positive individuals are referred for primary care to the Aldredge Health Center in downtown Atlanta. **Tuberculin** skin testing for Tuberculosis is also available at North Fulton Regional Health Center.

Dental services provide several educational and screening programs to assist children ages 3 to 17 in maintaining good oral health. Modern dental equipment allow the center to provide thorough assessments of oral health needs and offer a complete list of services, including cleanings, examinations, restoration and extractions.

Immunization services are available for children and adults to prevent the occurrence and transmission of vaccine-preventable diseases. Children are inoculated against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, hemophilus influenza type B, Hepatitis A, B, and chickenpox.

Nutrition and WIC services include counseling and a special supplemental nutrition program to help pregnant women, new mothers and their infants improve their eating habits and nutritional status. Food vouchers are issued to eligible individuals who have specific medical/nutritional risk factors.



Travel Clinic administers vaccines and provides consultation to clients preparing to travel abroad. Travelers can receive educational materials on topics such as traveler's diarrhea, air and sea sickness, and risk factors for other illnesses associated with traveling.

Women's Health services provide family planning, pregnancy testing, Pap smear tests, and pelvic and breast exams. Women age 50 and older can also receive referrals for mammography screening as well as follow-up care.

Environmental Health services help ensure that residents and visitors of Fulton County enjoy clean and safe recreational and living environments. Environmental Health Programs offered at the North Fulton Regional Health Center include West Nile virus prevention; permitting and inspection of more than 1,000 North Fulton food establishments, swimming pools, sewage disposal systems, hotels and other tourist accommodations.
