These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by Fulton County.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about August 27, 2013, Fulton County will submit a request to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the release of federal funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1977 (Public Law 930383) for the following purposes:

1. Project Name: City of Union City

Project Scope: Drainage Improvements

Location: Shannan Boulevard, Union City, GA

Cost: \$57,255.00 - Fiscal Year 2013 and \$57,255.00 – Fiscal Year 2014 projected estimate

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

Fulton County has determined that the projects will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at Fulton County Housing and Human Services Department, 137 Peachtree Street, S.W., Suite 300, Atlanta, GA 30303 and may be examined or copied weekdays 8:30A.M. to 5:00P.M.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Any individual, group, or agency disagreeing with this determination or wishing to comment on the project may submit written comments to Fulton County Department of Housing and Human Services. Such written comments should be addressed to Linda Callaway, Community Development Specialist, at the above referenced address on or before August 26, 2013. Comments may also be submitted via electronic mail to linda.callaway@fultoncountyga.gov. All comments received by August 26, 2013 will be considered by Fulton County prior to authorizing submission of a Request For Release of Funds (RROF). Commenters should specify which part of this notice they are addressing.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

Fulton County certified to HUD that Gerry B. Easley, in his capacity as Interim Director, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfied its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows Fulton County to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS

HUD will consider objections to its release of funds and Fulton County's certification received by September 12, 2013 or a period of fifteen days from its receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if there is one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer or other officer of Fulton County approved by HUD; or (b) Fulton County has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the project have committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from; the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Office of Community Planning and Development, 40 Marietta Street, 11th floor, Atlanta, GA 30303. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
