Frequently Asked Questions

Who is responsible for preparing the 2011 Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP)?

Fulton County staff in the Department of Public Works is responsible for managing the process of preparing the plan. They will work with residents, stakeholder groups and governing organizations in shaping the final product.

What is the timeframe for completion?

The SWMP is scheduled to be completed in the Fall of 2011. Implementation of the Plan will be ongoing through the next ten years.

How does the 2011 SWMP get implemented?

When implemented, the SWMP will provide strategies that will focus on reducing environmental impact and extending the life of regional landfills through its five core elements of waste reduction, education & public involvement, disposal, collection and land limitation.

Why should I participate in the 2011 SWMP process?

Participating in the SWMP development process ensures that the plan continues to reflect the interests and concerns of Fulton County residents, business and other interested groups.
