Schedules

The project will be released for advertisement in August 2011. The construction period for the pump station improvements is scheduled for spring of 2012 and will end in the fall of 2012.

Fulton County Public Works will improve the existing Amersee Pump Station located in the Amersee Lakes subdivision, 9100 Etching Overlook, Duluth/Fulton County. The purpose of the project is to replace two existing large pumps with smaller pumps (flow is re-directed to Chattahoochee III pump station), the addition of a carbon odor control system, the replacement of an existing emergency generator (switch gear included) and site lighting.

Project Benefits

The pump station improvements will increase the efficiency of the existing pumps, reduce odor emanating from the pump station, create reliable back up power and increase the night time visibility of the pump station.

Current Status

Current status as of 6-6-12: Contract awarded to Sol Construction, LLC.

Current schedule shows work will be complete after site lighting and alarm wiring. Project ahead of schedule.
