


Governance is a Partnership





What does the City of Atlanta do?

- Provide public safety services
 - 911, Police, Fire
- Provide planning and zoning services
- Provide parks & recreation services
- Build and maintain roads and sidewalks
- Build and maintain water and sewer systems
- Governed by Mayor & City Council





What does Fulton County do?

- Provide health & human services
 - Health & Wellness
 - Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, Addictive Diseases
 - Human Services
 - Ambulance dispatch
- Provide quality of life services
 - Library
 - Arts





What does Fulton County fund?

Elections, Taxes, Courts



- Provide voter registration and hold elections
- Assess and collect property taxes
- Fund a justice system and jail





What does Fulton County fund?

Grady Health System Funding



- Fulton and DeKalb Counties make annual contributions to the Grady Health System operating budget for indigent care
- Fulton County's 2007 contribution - \$ 80.3 million
- Grady Health System is not funded by the city of Atlanta





What does Fulton County do?

- Countywide services are mandated by state law and are not affected by incorporation or annexation in various portions of the County





What does Fulton County do?

The Board of Commissioners



- Fulton County is governed by a 7-member Board of Commissioners
- Responsible for establishing priorities and allocating funding
- Meets the first and third Wednesday of each month at 10 a.m.
- Each citizen in the County is represented by one district commissioner and two at-large commissioners





Fulton County At Work: Library Services



- The Atlanta-Fulton Public Library System received a \$1 million budget enhancement for 2007.
- This increase has already been reflected in increased purchases of children's and audio-visual materials
- In April, the library will add an online service called the Georgia High School test, to help prepare high school students for standardized tests. E-resources were also enhanced through the library materials budget.
