QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least twenty (20) years of age
- Must be a citizen of the United States
- Must have a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent (G.E.D.)
- Must be able to pass a polygraph, psychological exam, and a physical
- Not have been convicted by any state or the federal government of any crime, the punishment for which could have been imprisonment in a federal or state prison or institution
- Associate Degree in Criminal Justice or related field
- Successful completion of Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST)

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Serves civil processes. Interprets court orders, levies, and attachments.
- Makes decisions to arrest or set a court date on criminal warrants.
- Provides security for the Fulton County State and Magistrate Courts.
- Acts as Bailiff and supervises jurors in the State and Magistrate Courts. Assists and interacts with the general public to provide court-related services.
- Communicates with departmental staff, other law enforcement agencies, and the general public.
- Responds to calls for assistance from other law enforcement agencies. Enforces state and local laws and makes arrests.
- Operates vehicles to carry out supervisory directives as required.
