 - Work to engage new agencies to understand their community engagement and identify gaps the commission can fill.
 - Members also discussed the potential for expanding the Pack Act.
- Fulton County Board of Commissioners Designating Fulton County, GA as a Purple Heart
 - O Resolution proposed by Commissioner Arrington declaring Fulton County a Purple Heart County.
- Funding for Sons of Atlanta
 - O Discussion on fund raising. Clarification provided that due to lack of staff and resources, the group cannot operate as a nonprofit organization.
 - O Suggestions made to have another agency operate the nonprofit aspects.
 - O Also discussed: a 501 (c) (3) which is similar to a 501 (c)(19) has the necessary skills and experience to manage a nonprofit organization.
