Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Moratorium on Evictions Extended to January 31, 2021

The moratorium on evictions has been extended. Congress passed a stimulus bill and President Trump signed it into law on December 27, 2020.

*This bill included a provision that extends the CDC's Moratorium on evictions from its current deadline of December 31, 2020 to **January 31, 2021**.*

All other requirements of the CDC Moratorium originally in place on September 4, 2020 remain in full effect and *do not change*. The Court continues to work closely with Fulton County Marshal Maria McKee to ensure that cases falling within these guidelines are handled appropriately.
