When temperatures drop, water pipes can be vulnerable to freezing. Use these tips to help you prepare for the weather and prevent costly damage:



Seal any gaps in your foundation or walls to prevent drafts around pipes.



Add weather-stripping and door sweeps to prevent drafts around doors.



Insulate any exposed pipes with foam pipe insulation.



Disconnect garden hoses and put insulated covers over outdoor faucets.



When traveling, leave heat at 55 degrees or above in your home.



During freeze warnings:

- Leave under-sink cabinets open to allow warm air to circulate around pipes.
- Let a thin stream of water (pencil tip size) run from the faucet.



Make sure everyone in the household knows how to find and use the main water shutoff valve.



If you have a pipe freeze, turn off the main water shutoff before attempting to thaw it. Never use an open flame.



If the pipe appears damaged in any way, turn off the main water shutoff and call a licensed plumber.
