
Our Water, Our Future

Partnership for the Future

Fulton County Public Works strives each day to conserve and protect our water resources by building, operating and maintaining our water and wastewater infrastructure in an efficient and environmentally sound manner. However, our work alone is not enough. Fulton County citizens play a part in protecting our water by becoming partners with us in water stewardship.

Sadly, one of the biggest problems for our waterways is litter and illegal dumping. These activities not only threaten our watersheds, they also create unappealing sights in our communities. Residents who are concerned about litter in their neighborhoods should contact us for educational presentations or materials, cleanup supplies, and planning assistance for groups that would like to organize a litter cleanup in their area.


Another way residents can partner with us to protect our water is by volunteering their time to mark storm drains or to monitor water quality in their local stream through the GA Adopt-A-Stream program. Storm drain marking is excellent as a one-time event for groups, adding markers to storm drains in their neighborhood that remind residents not to dump anything, such as leaves or debris, down the storm drains. Public Works provides supplies and planning assistance for these events. Becoming an Adopt-A-Stream volunteer is a longer-term commitment where citizens attend a workshop to gain access to the knowledge and tools needed to monitor the health of surface waters in their watershed.

We also rely on our citizens to do their part in reducing the amount of water they use in Fulton County. Our water comes from the Chattahoochee River, a relatively small water source that provides water to so many people. We can protect that water source by irrigating wisely, updating our homes with high-efficiency WaterSense labeled water fixtures and by maintaining our home plumbing systems regularly and checking for leaks often. Public Works offers a rebate program for eligible water customers replacing older toilets, as well as offering conservation materials such as leak detection dye tablets and high efficiency showerheads. In addition, we offer workshops focused on home leak detection, winterizing home plumbing, and installing rain barrels for irrigation to help our customers lower their bills and reduce their use.
