ELECTION DAY OPERATIONS

Completed the Election Day Reconciliation for the September 23, 2025, Special Election. Recruited 1,106 Poll Workers for the November 4, 2025. General and Special Election. Election Day and training started on September 23, 2025. To date we have trained 125 Poll Workers.

FINANCE

PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

We have completed the draft 2026 Elections and Operating budget. The Elections budget for 2026 includes four election cycles. The draft 2026 budgets were submitted in September 2025 to the Finance department for further review by the Fulton County budget committee. The draft budget for 2026 is noted below.

The Fulton County Board of Commissioners (BOC) approved the 2025 Elections budget for a total of \$15 Million which included funding for the four PSC/Municipal elections. The approved 2025 Operating budget is \$5.4 Million.

The Financial Systems manager has continued to update the 2025 budget reporting. We have updated the budgets for the November 4, 2025, and the December 2, 2025 elections. We have prepared a budget for November 18, 2025, special called election for State Senate 35 and for the possible special run-off election on December 16, 2025. We have completed a budget for August 26, 2025, special called election for State Senate 21 and for the special run-off election on September 23, 2025.

We are continuing to process the vendor invoices for expenses incurred for 2025 elections work.

We continue to review the budget to actual costs for the 2025 Election cycles. We are generating both the Accounting and Purchase order reports to review our costs and to stay within our budget.

In September, the Information Systems division worked on the following items:

1. September 23rd Special Runoff Election

The Information Systems team successfully completed all preparations and support activities for the State Senate District 21 Special Runoff Election. Key responsibilities included:

- Logic & Accuracy (L&A) Testing: Conducted L&A testing and programmed all voting equipment for both Advance Voting and Election Day sites. Testing began on September 8th.
- Technical Support: Provided ongoing technical support throughout Advance Voting and on Election Day to ensure smooth operations across all polling locations.
- Election Night Operations: Closed out Advance Voting tabulators, uploaded memory cards from precincts, tabulated results, and transmitted reports to the Secretary of State.
- **Post-Election Activities:** Received all voting equipment, completed final tabulation, and prepared official reports for election certification.

2. November 4th Statewide Municipal Election

Preparations for the November 4th General Municipal Election began in September. Information Systems staff coordinated scheduling and planning for Logic & Accuracy testing to ensure timely readiness of equipment.

3. Poll Pad Updates

In preparation for the November election cycle and the 2025 election year, staff completed In preparation for the November election cycle and the 2025 election year, staff completed software updates approved by the Secretary of State.

REGISTRATION

DATE OF REPORT: September 30, 2025

PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

This Monthly Report summarizes key registration activities, workload levels, and voter registration statistics for the Registration Division of the Fulton County Registration & Elections Department for September 2025. Throughout the month, the VR staff focused on processing voter cancellation requests, conducting allowed list maintenance activities in the Georgia Registered Voter Information System (GARViS) due to the July 28th cutoff period for the State Senate District 21 election, and continuously auditing the voter roll. An in-person training session was held for all Registration division staff 9/20/25. System was reopened 9/27/25 and team worked over the weekend to start processing backlog. Additionally, the Registration Division provided support to Advance Voting and Election Day poll workers and voters and handled all post-election duties which included processing provisional ballots and retention responsibilities.

PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

In September, the Voter Education and Outreach team concentrated on promoting National Voter Registration Day, a civic holiday. They partnered with Atlanta Public Schools, Fulton County Schools, and local colleges and universities to raise awareness about upcoming elections and offer students opportunities to register to vote. The VEO manager also emailed the City Clerks, Mayors, and Council members of all 15 cities, providing key dates, promotional materials, and flyers for early voting in the November 4th and November 18th elections. The VEO manager continues engaging with all cities to keep residents informed about the upcoming elections. Additionally, the VEO Manager has contacted all senior centers where the team has visited this year to follow up and schedule visits before the Voter Registration deadline, ensuring that new residents have the opportunity to register and apply for their absentee ballots.

The VEO manager led an Election Academy session for citizens interested in learning more about the Elections Department and continues to conduct Deputy Registrar training for new and returning citizens who want to help Fulton County by hosting voter registration drives.

The VEO Manager stays informed and participates in all sessions of the GA House of Representatives Blue-Ribbon Study Committee on elections, providing updates about proposed legislation affecting elections next year to the Leadership team. The next meeting is scheduled to be held in Covington, Georgia, on Thursday, October 2, 2025. The VEO Manager also continues to monitor all GA Election Board meetings.

The VEO Manager participated in the planning committee for the GAVREO Region 3 training session, held by Fulton County at the Elections Hub, and presented a workshop on Voter Education and Outreach in preparation for the 2026 election. The VEO Manager also attended Digital Accessibility training to ensure readiness for complying with the new digital accessibility requirements passed by the Department of Justice, which go into effect on April 24, 2026.

The VEO team is also preparing for National Voter Education Week, National Vote Early Day, and Election Hero Day, which are civic holidays observed in October and November.

The VEO team continues to plan events and will continue to reach out to schools, community groups, nonprofits, and government officials to organize future activities across the county.
