#3– BRIEF UPDATE ON ELECTION OPERATIONS

Chair Allen requested an update on election day operations.

Director Williams greeted the BRE and provided an update:

- 130 locations Polling locations open on-time and fully operational
- Midday incident at one location- Ison Spring Elementary (SS19A & SS22)
 - Closed at 11:58am- 4:00pm
 - Locked down for 4 hours
 - Legal filed a court order to extend voting
 - Poll will not close until 11:02pm
- Approximate totals:
 - **93K+** Election Day
 - **120K+** Advance Voting
 - **2.3K+** Absentee By Mail

Ms. Adams asked were there any poll pad issues.

Director Williams answered no, nothing that would impact voting.

Chair Allen commented on visiting Election Day locations and none her the locations she visited expressed concerns.

Mrs. Crawford thanked the poll workers and the locations she visited to seem like smooth election

Ms. Adams thanked the poll workers that were on lockdown and that has to operate the Ison Spring Elementary polling location until 11:02pm.
