#3– BRIEF DISCUSSION ON THE RECANVASSING POLICY

Ms. Adams asked for clarification on the policy or procedures for rescanning ballots.

Director Williams explained the standard operating procedure.

Ms. Adams inquired about the daily ballot pick-up and when those ballots are counted.

Director Williams responded that the ballots are counted daily.

Ms. Adams expressed concerns of possible lapse in Chain of Custody (COC).

Director Williams explained that COC is maintained fully.

Mr. Selby interjected and requested legal weigh in on the inquiry due possible pending litigation.

Attorney Pachuta explained that she was made aware of a complaint filed during the SEB Hearing, but she does not have anything official regarding that matter.

Mr. Selby requested that **Director Williams** limit her response to discuss due to possible or pending litigation.

Director Williams reiterated the SOPs for daily ballot pick-up and counting.

Ms. Adams asked about the COC once the ballots were returned in-house.

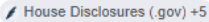
Director Williams reiterated her previous response.

#4– BRIEF DISCUSSION TO AMEND THE SCHEDULE TIME

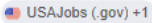
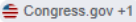
Chair Allen requested the time change for the June 22, 2026, Monday meeting due to scheduling conflict.

Chair Allen entertained a motion to change the meeting time to 1pm instead of 11am, due to conflict. The motion was made by **Ms. Adams**, seconded by **Mr. Selby** and carried by a unanimous vote of 4-0.

#5– BRIEF DISCUSSION TO FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE REPORT

A financial disclosure report is a mandated statement that details an individual's or organization's financial holdings, income, liabilities, and transactions. In the public sector, these reports are used to prevent conflicts of interest. In family law or corporate disputes, they ensure complete financial transparency. 

Public Sector & Government

- **Who files:** Required for high-level officials, including members of Congress, federal judges, the President, and certain executive branch employees. 
- **What's included:** Earned income, gifts, property, stock/bond transactions, liabilities, and outside positions. 

Attorney Alexis the County Code of Ethics does require some boards to submit this information.

Mr. Selby inquired about it requires some boards, just not this board.

Attorney Alexis said BRE was not included.

Chair Allen informed the board that she completed the form voluntarily.

Mr. Selby asked should we defer this discussion to the next Regular Meeting.

Mr. Selby informed the BRE that boards he served are subject to Financial Disclosure Forms

Ms. Crawford explained that the last board she served on in another state required a financial disclosure form.
