#### Monthly Operational Summary

For the month of April, the Advance Voting Team has been fully engaged in the recruitment, coordination, and execution efforts for the upcoming May 19 General Primary/Special Election. Advance Voting operations officially commenced on April 27, 2026, with the Division providing ongoing oversight and support to all **32** Advance Voting locations across the county.

The Team has been focused on ensuring site readiness, staffing coverage, and compliance with state election procedures. Field support has remained a top priority, with teams actively addressing real-time operational needs to maintain efficiency and minimize disruptions at voting locations.

The Team continues to maintain consistent coordination through weekly meetings with Division Managers. These meetings serve to align priorities, share critical operational updates, address challenges, and ensure clear, consistent communication across all Advance Voting functions. This structured approach has supported a unified operation and strengthened responsiveness throughout the Advance voting period.

## FINANCE

**DATE OF REPORT:** 04/30/2026

**PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

The 2026 Elections and Operating budget was approved by the Fulton County Board of Commissions (BOC) on January 21, 2026. The approved 2026 Elections budget totals \$26.1 Million and includes funding for four election cycles during the year. In addition, the Operating budget is \$5.4 Million, which funds the salaries of permanent personnel, employee benefits, insurance, software and hardware costs.

As part of the approval process, the Fulton County BOC required a total reduction of \$1.3 Million. This consisted of: A \$1 Million reduction by the Fulton County BOC, and an additional 1% reduction of \$348K mandated by the Finance department for all departments.

We made the following reductions to the 2026 Elections budget to achieve the required total \$1.3 Million reduction. The temp agency bids were hybrid with higher markup rates for temps who are driving vs non-driving temps. The temp markup rates were updated in the 2026 Elections budget which reduced the total temp labor costs. We reduced the total number of advanced voting election sites from 37 down to 32. Some of the temporary staffing start dates were delayed by one week. We also eliminated 1 Sunday of advanced voting which reduced the staff overtime costs.

We are continuing to update the 2026 Elections budget as new purchase needs arise to operate the elections. We work with the Director and management team in making budget revisions.

We are processing the 2026 vendor invoices for the established purchase orders funded by the approved Elections budget. We are monitoring the budget to actual expenditures for the 2026 elections. We are generating both the Accounting and Purchase order reports to track costs and to adhere to our budgets.

We are processing the few remaining 2025 expenses that were received in 2026. We continue to review the budget to actual expenditures for the 2025 Election cycles.

For the month of April 2026, the Supply and Logistics Division worked on and or completed the following:

- Performed site visits at current polling locations to update information on the facilities and to verify how locations were set up.
- Supply and Logistics staff completed Advance Voting polling location equipment and supply deliveries for May 19, 2026, General Primary Election.
- 65 temporary couriers were onboarded to staff the elections warehouse and to complete Advance Voting polling location deliveries and Advance Voting polling location support for May 19, 2026, General Primary Election.
- Provide logistical support to both the Advance Voting and Election Day training locations for May 19, 2026, General Primary Election.
- Processed all new Fulton County Registration and Elections fleet additions in preparation for use during the 2026 election cycle.

- Staff worked on creating logistics plans for Advance Voting and Election Day polling location support for May 19, 2026, General Primary
- Staff provided logistical and supply support for all 32 Advance Voting Polling Locations by sending supplies or providing any other assistance requested by the Advance Voting Locations during the Advance Voting period.
- Completed preparation of all the 96 Advance Voting Supply Boxes for the May 19, 2026, Advance Voting period.
- Provided absentee ballot drop box support by picking up any absentee ballots dropped into the 7 absentee ballot drop boxes and transferring them to the Absentee Ballot Division during May 19, 2026, General Primary Election.
- Completed 131 Election Day supply boxes for May 19, 2026, General Primary Election.
- Started preparing the Election Day Supply bags that will be picked up by Poll Managers on Sunday Pickup for May 19, 2026, General Primary Election.
- The staff continued to conduct day-to-day logistics operations for the Elections Warehouse.

## VOTER EDUCATION

**DATE OF REPORT:** April 30, 2026,

**PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

In April, the Voter Education and Outreach (VEO) team focused on outreach at all Fulton County colleges and libraries and continued our work with high school students at APS and Fulton County schools. The VEO manager focused on outreach to all 15 municipalities, ensuring they received all primary election marketing collateral via email. The VEO also delivered hard copies of all marketing collateral to all 15 city halls.

The VEO team continues to conduct Deputy Registrar training and to work with Deputy Registrars to conduct voter registration drives throughout the county. The VEO manager also conducted Deputy Registrar training sessions for all advanced voting managers and assistant managers to ensure they were up to date on rules and regulations for the start of advance voting. The VEO manager also worked with the High Museum of Art to continue the partnership to host VEO events at the Museum, given that the Museum will not serve as an advance voting location for the primary election.

The VEO manager participates in legislative meetings as needed to discuss all bills that affect the elections department, attends State Election Board meetings to hear about potential rules that will affect the elections office, and attends committee meetings to hear election-related bills. There were 2 meetings in April to discuss the aftermath of the general assembly's failure to pass any legislation addressing compliance with SB 189. We were told to wait and see whether the Governor will call a special session. The VEO manager also hosted the Elections Academy and participated in the Experience Fulton podcast with the external affairs team.

The VEO Team is continually planning events and will continue to contact schools, communities, nonprofit organizations, and government officials to schedule future events across the county.
