## FINANCE

**DATE OF REPORT:** 06/02/2026

**PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

The 2026 Elections and Operating budget was approved by the Fulton County Board of Commissions (BOC) on January 21, 2026. The approved 2026 Elections budget totals \$26.1 Million and includes funding for four election cycles during the year. In addition, the Operating budget is \$5.4 Million, which funds the salaries of permanent personnel, employee benefits, insurance, software and hardware costs.

As part of the approval process, the Fulton County BOC required a total reduction of \$1.3 Million. This consisted of: A \$1 Million reduction by the Fulton County BOC, and an additional 1% reduction of \$348K mandated by the Finance department for all departments.

We made the following reductions to the 2026 Elections budget to achieve the required total \$1.3 Million reduction. The temp agency bids were hybrid with higher markup rates for temps who are driving vs non-driving temps. The temp markup rates were updated in the 2026 Elections budget which reduced the total temp labor costs. We reduced the total number of advanced voting election sites from 37 down to 32. Some of the temporary staffing start dates were delayed by one week. We also eliminated 1 Sunday of advanced voting which reduced the staff overtime costs.

We are continuing to update the 2026 Elections budget as new purchase needs arise to operate the elections. We continue to work with the Director and management team in making budget revisions.

We are processing the 2026 vendor invoices for the established purchase orders funded by the approved Elections budget. We are monitoring the budget to actual expenditures for the 2026 elections. We are generating both the Accounting and Purchase order reports to track costs and to adhere to our budgets.

We are updating the temporary staffing budgets for the upcoming November and December 2026 election cycles to prepare for the statewide temporary staffing contract renewal for July 2026, the start of the state of Georgia's fiscal year. The statewide temporary staffing contract is utilized to provide us with the temporary staffing agencies.

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In May, the Information Systems Division completed several key operational activities in support of election readiness, election administration, and post-election processing.

#### 1. May 19, 2026 General Primary Election

The Information Systems team completed all preparation, operational, and post-election activities for the May 19, 2026 General Primary Election. Key responsibilities included:

**Election Night Operations** The team closed out Advance Voting tabulators, uploaded memory cards from Election Day precincts, tabulated results, and transmitted required reports to the Secretary of State.

**Post-Election Activities:** The team received voting equipment, completed the final tabulation process, and prepared official reports for certification.

**Risk-Limiting Audit:** The team set up all ARLO submissions required to support the Risk-Limiting Audit process.

**Image Audit:** The team set up and began the Image Audit process.

#### 2. June 16, 2026, General Primary Runoff Special Election

In preparation for the June 16, 2026, General Primary Runoff Special Election, the Information Systems team began carrying out the full scope of election-readiness responsibilities, including:

**Logic & Accuracy Testing** The team began L&A testing and programming of voting equipment for both Advance Voting and Election Day.

**Technical Support Planning** The team developed technical support plans for Advance Voting and Election Day to help maintain smooth operational performance and timely response to issues.

**Election Night Operations Planning:** The team planned Election Night functions, including Advance Voting tabulator closure, precinct memory card uploads, tabulation of results, and transmission of reports to the Secretary of State.

- Provided Logistical support to the 130 Election Day polling locations on May 19, 2026, by providing them with setup assistance or any supplies or deliveries they needed.
- Completed all the Election Day Equipment and Supply pickups for the May 19, 2026, General Primary.
- Completed preparing the Election Day Supply bags that will be picked up by Poll Managers on Sunday Pickup for the May 19, 2026, General Primary Election.
- Staff completed all reconciliation duties for May 19, 2026, General Primary.
- Supply staff started preparing all the Advance Voting Supply boxes in preparation for the upcoming June 16, 2026, General Primary Runoff.
- Started preparing the Election Day Supply boxes for the Upcoming June 16, 2026, General Primary Runoff.
- Staff begin preparing the delivery and pickup schedules for the upcoming June 16, 2026, General Primary Runoff.
- The staff continued to conduct day-to-day logistics operations for the Elections Warehouse.

## VOTER EDUCATION

**DATE OF REPORT:** May 31, 2026

**PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:**

In May, the Voter Education and Outreach (VEO) team focused on community outreach events across the county to promote the 2026 election. The team also dropped off voter education materials at all Fulton County city halls, libraries, and recreation centers. The VEO manager focused on outreach to all 15 municipalities, providing mayors, city council members, and city clerks with updated information about the May election for use in advertising on their city websites and in newsletters. The manager also sent voter education materials to churches and senior centers within Fulton County to promote the election. The team also worked with several high schools to conduct voter education and outreach at senior events. The VEO manager partnered with the City of Atlanta clerk to hold voter education training for councilmembers' staff to ensure they were aware of all election rules and updates.

The VEO team continues to conduct Deputy Registrar training and to work with Deputy Registrars to conduct voter registration drives throughout the county. The VEO manager also worked with UniverSoul Circus to host voter education and outreach at the circus.

The VEO Manager conducted training for the Risk Limiting Audit to be held after the May 19, 2026, General Primary election is certified. The RLA begins on May 29th and must be completed by June 2, 2026, at 5 p.m.

The VEO manager participates in legislative meetings as needed to discuss all bills affecting the elections department, attends State Election Board meetings to hear about potential rules that will affect the elections office, and attends committee meetings to hear election-related bills. The Governor has called a special session on June 17th to discuss redistricting and the voting mechanism to be used after July 1, 2026, when QR codes are no longer allowed on ballots, to ensure compliance with SB 189.

The VEO team is continually planning events and will continue to contact schools, communities, nonprofit organizations, and government officials to schedule future events across the county.
