FINANCE

DATE OF REPORT: 08/03/2026

PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

The 2026 Elections and Operating budget was approved by the Fulton County Board of Commissions (BOC) on January 21, 2026. The approved 2026 Elections budget totals \$26.1 Million and includes funding for four election cycles during the year. In addition, the Operating budget is \$5.4 Million, which funds the salaries of permanent personnel, employee benefits, insurance, software and hardware costs.

As part of the approval process, the Fulton County BOC required a total reduction of \$1.3 Million. This consisted of: A \$1 Million reduction by the Fulton County BOC, and an additional 1% reduction of \$348K mandated by the Finance department for all departments.

The 2026 Elections budget continues to be updated as new operational requirements are identified. We are working closely with the Elections Director and management team to evaluate emerging needs and make the necessary budget revisions to ensure adequate funding for election operations.

We are processing the 2026 vendor invoices for the established purchase orders funded by the approved Elections budget. Budget-to-actual expenditures are being closely monitored, and both Accounting and Purchase Order reports are generated regularly to track costs and ensure expenditure remains within approved budget limits.

We are currently working on the 2027 municipal election budgets. The 2027 budgets are due to the Finance department in September 2026.

- Continued coordinating supply and equipment procurement efforts in support of the November and December 2026 elections, including order tracking, delivery planning, and vendor communication.
- Continued diagnostic testing of Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) units to verify battery integrity and charging performance before placement into storage for future deployment.
- Reviewed and updated Information Systems standard operating procedures (SOPs) to ensure operational processes, system support procedures, and election readiness documentation remain current.
- Communicated with all departmental technology vendors to plan and coordinate required platform, software, and device updates in preparation for the November and December 2026 elections.

PREPARATION FOR ELECTION / WORK SUMMARY:

In July, the Voter Education and Outreach (VEO) team focused on scheduling voter education events at high school open houses and at colleges and universities during orientation. Once August begins, the team will ensure there is a voter registration event at each Fulton County high school and university and will plan events for Poll Worker Recruitment Day. Using the VEO Intern project, the team will be intentional about ensuring there are events in low-voter-turnout areas. The VEO team continues to conduct Deputy Registrar training and to work with Deputy Registrars to conduct voter registration drives throughout the county.

The VEO Manager helped coordinate a tour for the Partnership for Large Election Jurisdiction (PLEJ) Conference. She participated in a panel at the conference to discuss our outreach across the county.

The VEO team is continually planning events and will continue to contact schools, communities, nonprofit organizations, and government officials to schedule future events throughout the county.
