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Fulton County Statement on Voter Roll Maintenance

Fulton County Registration & Elections is committed to the maintenance of voter rolls in order to ensure fair and secure elections.

With more than 800,000 registered voters, voter roll maintenance takes place daily through the Registration Division.

Voters are added, updated, and removed in compliance with verification processes outlined by State and Federal law, with procedures set by the Georgia Secretary of State's office. Updates take place due to a variety of life events, including a change of address, name change, achieving the legal voting age, death, felony conviction, and other life events.

It is important to note that both state and federal law require a "pause" of removal of voters for a period immediately prior to an election. Notification processes are in place to prevent erroneous removal of voters.
