Coney is accused of grabbing the child by "his upper arms causing visible injury, picking him up and pushing him into a wall, and yelling in his face," a warrant says. Police began investigating

the allegations July 13 after reports of the surveillance footage surfaced. Krystin Collier told Channel 2 Action News the video showed the women pulling her son off the ground by his hair and throwing him into a corner of the classroom. She said they also appeared to slap the child and punch him with a closed fist, accordhim by his upper ing to a police report.

The Fulton County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a 2022 millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 5.19 percent.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 9.33 mills, an increase of .46 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 8.87 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$437,500 is approximately \$66.70 and the proposed tax increase for a nonhomestead property with a fair market value of \$312,500 is approximately \$57.50.
